### 5. MEDICAL

Certain medical conditions are incompatible with flying duties. Staff must therefore be totally candid in providing complete disclosure of all medical conditions on their initial application for employment and to immediately advise of any medical changes in that may occur. Undisclosed medical

circumstances could result termination of employment since minimum medical standards must be maintained as a condition of holding a Transport Canada aircrew licence.  
Any and all medications ingested must be approved by a Canadian Forces Flight Surgeon (where available) or a Transport Canada approved Canadian Aviation Medical Examiner. Similarly, ingesting unapproved or undocumented medication may result in termination of employment.
