What is the Squadron Sponsoring Committee?

The Sponsoring Committee is comprised of volunteers who assist the Squadron with various needs.

The aim of the Sponsoring Committee (SSC) is to assist the Squadron in a variety of different support and financial roles. The Department of National Defence (DND) provides uniforms and partial funding to the training program; however, the Sponsoring Committee is responsible to provide funding for the facilities, operation and remainder of training expenses for the Squadron. This requires fundraising for the current and planned activities and for items such as instruments for the Pipes & Drums Band.

Informally, the Sponsoring Committee also assists with coordination for a variety of other events such as Squadron potluck dinners and community fundraising activities; provides support for Squadron events such as competitions and parades; assists with arranging for transportation needs and ensures adequate supplies are on hand. The Sponsoring Committee works closely with the CO and the Training Officer to keep apprised of upcoming activities to ensure adequate support is provided to meet the ongoing needs of the Squadron. Sponsoring Committee volunteers are not permitted to have “care and control” of the cadets - care and control of cadets belongs exclusively to DND/Squadron Officers.

Volunteers: As an adult volunteer you can play several roles within the cadet program. Most volunteers, often parents of a cadet, will become involved with the Sponsoring Committee, and will volunteer to be a member.

Cadet Mandatory Training

All cadets are expected to be present each Tuesday at the Guelph Armoury, 7 Wyndham Street Guelph, for their mandatory training. They are to report between 18:15- 18:30 (6:15pm- 6:30pm) and ends around 21:30 (9:30pm).

The evening consists of a parade and three classroom periods where the cadets learn various topics from aerospace, Military ranks and history to leadership.
